Why Kindergarteners Should Be Excited to Be in My Class:

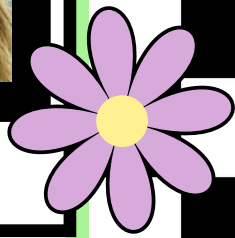
